### Hotel Saint George

Accommodations in the arty, high desert town of **Marfa, Tex.** include motels, vintage trailers and teepee campgrounds — and now, the design-savvy Hotel Saint George. Looking onto remote, dusty cowboy country, its 55 minimalist, gray-washed rooms are outfitted with soft Australian sheepskin rugs and regional art by the Texas-based artist Mark Flood. And in the lobby is the new outpost of the Marfa Book Company, which functions as a bookstore, gift shop and performance space.
